Provincial Awards Procedures



1. All regions will allot agenda time at their regional meetings to inform the branches and request nominations for the various provincial awards: **Gordon Lund Memorial Award, Resource Management Conservation Award, Ed Begin Conservation Project Award, Bill McDonald Youth Conservationist of the Year Award, and the Clayton Young Memorial Awards.**
2. Nomination forms for all awards will be available at every regional meeting and/or emailed to requesting branches by Central Office.
3. All award nominations must be sent directly to SWF Central Office no later than January 1st. Existing criteria will be used to determine the winners for each award by the Board of Directors, with the exception of the Ed Begin Conservation Project Award, which is voted on at the annual convention by the delegates.
4. Nominations should be complete and concise, and include an informative explanation of the nominee's accomplishments. The judges for these awards will base their decision on the quality and information supplied on the nomination forms.
5. Awards will be presented at the annual SWF Convention each February.

An **Honorary Life Membership** may be presented for outstanding contributions to the promotion of the objectives of the Saskatchewan Wildlife Federation. Nominees must have made an outstanding contribution, provincially, to the Saskatchewan Wildlife Federation and/or to the conservation of Saskatchewan's natural resources. Nominations by a branch, in writing, must be received by the SWF Central Office, and must include a description of the nominee's contribution. The SWF Board of Directors shall approve or reject all nominations. An Honorary Life Membership may be presented at the annual convention, or time and place designated by the SWF Board of Directors.
