

## National Archery in the Schools Program (NASP)

### Saskatchewan Equipment Grant

NASP is offering grants for new schools wanting to start a program in their school and for existing NASP schools to replace aging equipment. Each new school must purchase a standard kit from the Saskatchewan Wildlife Federation (SWF) and use the grant money towards this purchase. Replacement equipment must be purchased through SWF. The equipment must be purchased and paid for before December 31, 2016. Any of the new schools must have NASP certified teachers (BAI) or have a BAI training before the equipment will be delivered to the school. This BAI certification needs to take place before December 31, 2016.
