Intended to support pollinators in backyards, communities, and schools, the Backyard Biodiversity Challenge allows parents, SWF members, and the public to request packages of Saskatchewan wildflower seeds to plant in their backyard. Included along with the package are the tools and information required to learn about pollinators, and why they are important, as well as how to monitor the flowers, and use the scientific method.

The program was another huge success in 2023, with numerous schools, organizations, and individuals jumping on board for the challenge. We hope to see the program uptake again this summer!
