Following is a list of the SWF Henry Kelsey Official Measurers. Heads must be measured by an official measurer to be entered into the Henry Kelsey Big Game Records and must be measured by December 31/24 to be eligible for the 2024 awards. Remember that there is no mandatory drying period, and these measurers are volunteers, so please don't wait until the Christmas holidays to have your trophy measured.

Don't forget to renew your SWF membership for 2025 (available now through your local branch executive or online) not only for eligibility for next year's awards, but for the insurance that covers you while hunting or fishing. Remember that to be eligible for HK awards, memberships must be purchased by April 1 for bear and August 1 for all other species
