SASKATCHEWAN MASTER ANGLER

In the coming months the SWF will be launching a new catch and release awards program called Saskatchewan Master Angler.

Anglers who catch fish of qualifying species will earn certificates and pins based on how many different species are caught. While open to the public, local Memberships will be promoted, and SWF members will be eligible for additional prizes and glory.



Official rules will be posted, but qualifying fish can be posted through the SWF website OR right from the water using the Saskatchewan Master Angler app. With the app, anglers will also have access to the Angler's Guide, Maps, Species Identification Tips, Official Rules, the ability to report tagged fish, and report invasive carp, making it useful even if your catching fish that look more like bait than a trophy.

Look for the program to launch this summer.

The Saskatchewan Wildlife Federation is reminding people that they can turn guns, antlers and hunting & fishing equipment into habitat for wildlife across the province, while receiving a tax-deductible receipt for their generosity.
