CWD Testing

Attention hunters!

Monitoring for bovine tuberculosis (TB) and chronic wasting disease (CWD) in wildlife populations is critical. This hunting season, hunters in WMZs 37, 39, 43, 47, 50 and 55 are required to submit the heads of any harvested deer or elk. Samples can be submitted to any designated CWD drop-off location within one month of the animal being harvested.

Bovine TB is a contagious chronic bacterial infection that primarily affects domestic cattle. It has never been found in Saskatchewan wildlife, but deer, elk and moose are susceptible to the disease.

Your diligence is key to early detection and ensuring that herds remain disease-free.

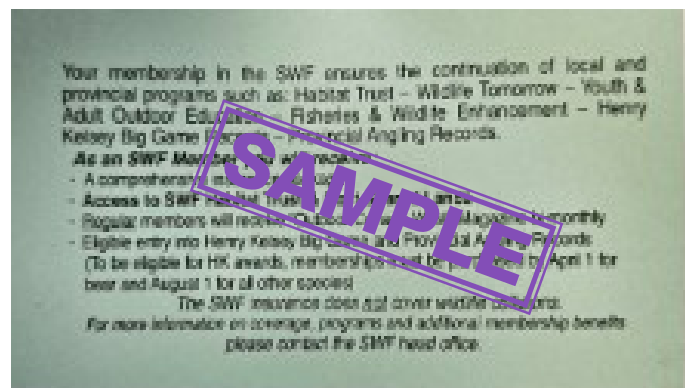
